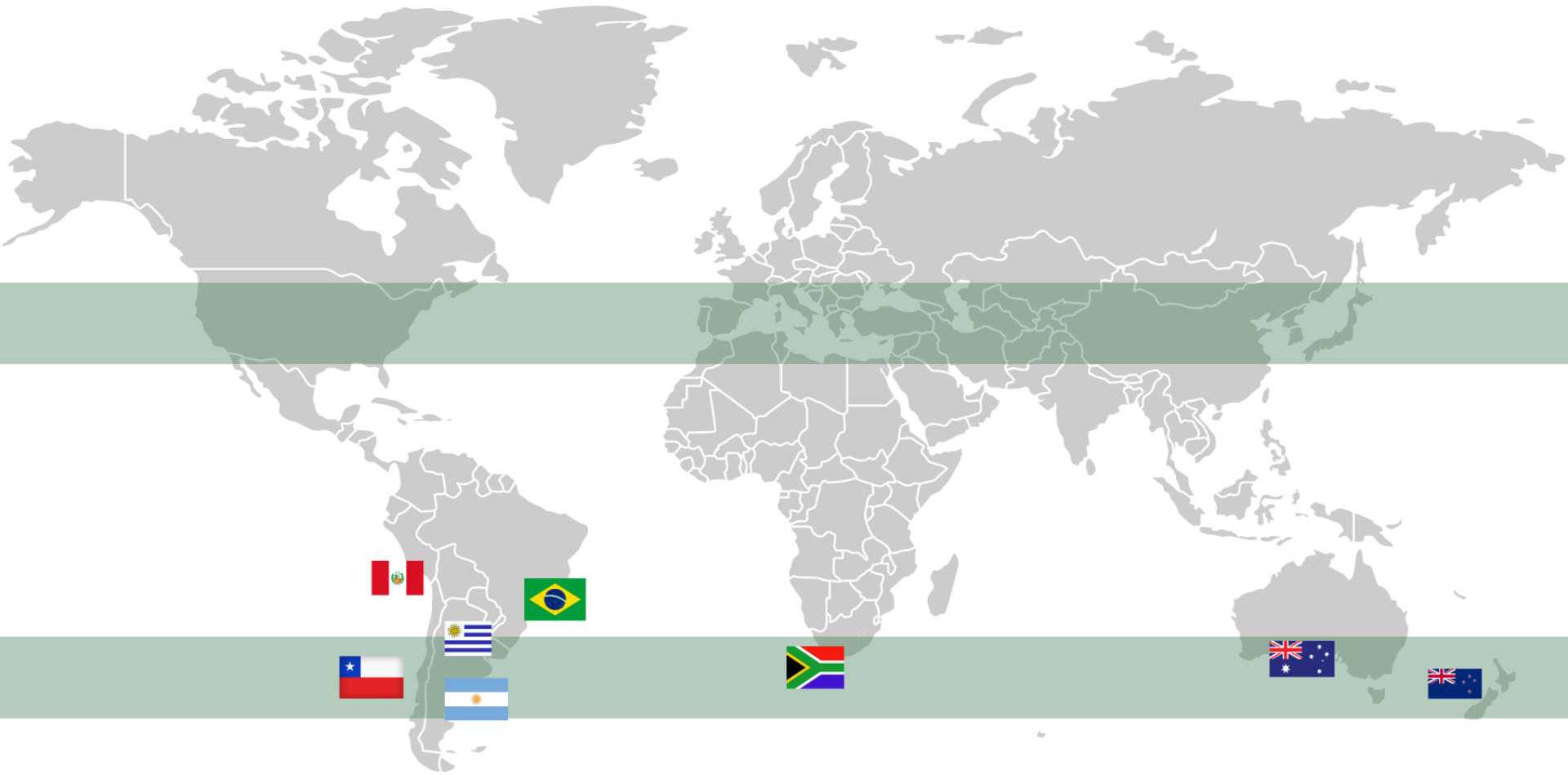

We harvest in the opposite time of year

Super High density production:

- Developed by Agromillora in the 90's,
- Low vigor varieties: Arbequina, Arbosana, Koroneiki.
- Planting frames (3 or 4 mts x 1 or 1.5 m) with high planting density (+1.600 - 2.200 plants/ha).
- Harvest with riding machine and fully mechanized pruning (lower production costs)
